Black Bob; The Light Division gains <i>Rapid Deployment</i> and either <i>Enthusiastic</i> or <i>Stoic</i> , the controlling player must choose at the start of the game. Outpost Duty; French Forces within 1 mile (12") of Light Division may not use dummy Objective markers. A Date with Death; Craufurd is mortally wounded at Ciudad Rodrigo, dying four days later. -2 to Leader Fate, 1812. Unavailable after January 1812.

Flirts with Death; -1 to Leader Fate, +2 if Harmed, 1812. Chosen Successor; If Wellington is removed by Leader Fate, Beresford must take command of the Army, after March 1812.

At the Battle of New Orleans, Pakenham is wounded by short range munitions from American artillery which explodes his knee, while being helped up by an aide, he is struck again in the arm. Once mounted on the aide's horse he is struck a third time, this time in the spine. He dies shortly thereafter, after directing his second-in-command to take command and commit the reserves. Unavailable after August 1814.
☑	Leith	Mid, Late Wars	-	-	1	0	2	1	1	Otherwise Engaged; Appointed governor of the Leeward Islands in 1814, Leith is focused on suppressing Napoléon's supporters there through 1815. Unavailable after January 1814. Flirts with Death; -1 in Leader Fate, +2 if Harmed, 1812, 1813.
